

Maytag, Jenn-Air, Amana, Admiral, Crosley, Magic Chef, and Performa by Maytag brand Refrigerator Recall

Date August 25, 2009

Product Name

Maytag[®], Magic Chef[®], Performa by Maytag[®] and Crosley[®] brand refrigerators

Full Product Description

This recall is being conducted by Maytag Corporation in voluntary cooperation with Health Canada and includes certain Maytag[®], Magic Chef[®], Performa by Maytag[®] and Crosley[®] brand side-by-side and top freezer refrigerators. The original "<u>recall</u>" was issued on March 10, 2009, and included about 193,500 units. The affected refrigerators were manufactured in black, bisque, white and stainless steel. They have model and serial numbers printed on a label located on the top middle or left upper side of the refrigerator liner and have the following model and serial number combinations:

Refrigerators with freezers on the bottom are not included in this recall.

Hazard Identified

An electrical failure in the relay, the component that turns on the refrigerator's compressor, can cause overheating and pose a serious fire hazard.

Three additional incidents and no injuries have been reported in Canada. Outside of Canada, Maytag has received 23 additional reports of refrigerator relay ignition, including four reports of property damage ranging from smoke damage to extensive kitchen damage.

Corrective Action

Consumers should immediately contact Maytag to determine if their refrigerator is included in the recall and if so, to schedule a free in-home repair. Consumers should not return the refrigerator to the retailer where it was purchased.

Approximately 17,000 units were sold at department and appliance stores and by homebuilders in Canada.


Time Period Sold

FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

Why is Maytag Corporation recalling these refrigerators?

The safety of Maytag Corporation customers is our top priority. Therefore, Maytag Corporation, in voluntary cooperation with Health Canada, is conducting a recall of approximately 193,500 Maytag®, Jenn-Air®, Amana®, Admiral®, Magic Chef®, Performa by Maytag® and Crosley® brand side-by-side and top freezer refrigerators due to fire hazard.

Why didn't Maytag test these refrigerators before marketing them?

The safety of Maytag Corporation customers is our top priority. Therefore, we conduct extensive product testing during all phases of development. If a safety issue is identified, we move swiftly to find affected units and resolve the issue.

Which refrigerators are being recalled?

Approximately 193,500 Maytag®, Jenn-Air®, Amana®, Admiral®, Magic Chef®, Performa by Maytag® and Crosley® brand side-by-side and top freezer refrigerators are being recalled. The affected refrigerators were manufactured in black, bisque, white and stainless steel. They have model and serial numbers printed on a label located on the top middle or left upper side of the refrigerator liner and have the following model and serial number combinations.

Refrigerators with freezers on the bottom are NOT included in this recall.

My refrigerator's model and serial numbers do not fall within the recalled range. Does that mean it is safe to continue using it?

Yes. If your refrigerator's model and serial number combination is not listed, it is not affected by this recall and you may continue to use it safely. This will ensure that your service technician has the proper repair kit and will guarantee that you will not be charged for the repair.
